



Oakfield Parkonians CC: Net Usage Terms and Conditions

In booking your net session you agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions. Please read the following carefully, as failure to adhere to these may result in the net booking privileges being withdrawn.

The following terms and conditions are compliant with the ECB guidelines which were announced on 15 May 2020. The Club reserves the right to amend these at any time in line with further ECB guidance which may be released.

Please note that to use nets you will need to register using the booking tool 'Skedda', you will be asked to confirm:

- A.** That you are a member of the Club and have paid the relevant fee.
- B.** A Club Representative is present.

You will then be able to book a time slot.

1. **Membership Fee**

In order to use the nets you will have to make a one-off payment in advance. This has been set at £30.00 for senior members and £20.00 for Colts and will be counted as a contribution towards this year's annual membership.

2. **Club Representative**

A nominated Club Representative must be present at all times that the nets are being used, Club Representatives are:

- All members of the Executive Committee
- All Senior Team Captains and Vice Captains
- Club Coaches
- Colts Age Group Managers

3. **Opening Times**

The nets will be available for use:
8:00am to 8:00pm Monday to Saturday
8:00am to 7:00pm Sunday

The nets need to be maintained to ensure that they are safe to use, this may require the nets to be closed between 10:00am and 12:00 noon on some days.

- One hour slots will be available with a 30 minute gap between sessions.
- Each household will be restricted to booking 2 nets per week.
- Do not arrive too early, please leave promptly when your session is complete and do not socialise.
- You should leave Club premises before the next users arrive,

4. **Government Guidelines**

- Follow current Government Guidelines at all times.
- Do not use the facility if you or a member of your household has symptoms of coronavirus however mild – observe government advice.

5. Nets Criteria

- Members are using the nets at their own risk.
- Net Rules apply and should be followed.
- Wash your hands at home before and after using the facility. Do not touch your face.
- Bring your own sanitiser for use.
- Maximum of two people using the net unless everyone is from the same household.
- Only one net lane is to be used.
- Observe social distancing rules at all times, maintain at least two metres unless participants are members of the same household.

6. Equipment

- Use your own equipment. We will not be providing Club equipment apart from stumps.
- Bring your own balls.
- Batsmen to bring and wear their own cricket PPE.
- No saliva or sweat should come into contact with the ball at any time.

7. Club Facilities

- The Clubhouse and Bar will be closed, therefore there is no access to the telephone, toilets or changing rooms.
- Bring your own mobile phone in case of emergencies.
- Bring your own filled drinking bottles.
- There will be no access allowed on the outfield.
